## **Rules of granite composite care:**

**Clean regularly:** Conduct thorough cleaning of the product once a week using the cleaning paste and sponge.

**Rinse and dry the surface thoroughly:** After applying the paste, rinse the surface thoroughly with water and dry it carefully, making sure that the surface is well cleaned and dried before applying the impregnation agent.

**Impregnate the surface:** Apply the impregnation agent evenly to the surface and leave it on for 10-15 minutes to absorb. Then remove any remaining impregnation agent by gently rubbing it into the surface with a cloth. Repeat the impregnation process at least once a week.

**Remove abrasions and scratches:** If minor scratches appear on the surface of the product, remove them using the impregnation agent.

With these simple steps, caring for composite surfaces will become easy and enjoyable.

# Instructions for cleaning Quartz Sinks

## Step 1

Clean the sink with hot soapy water , then wipe dry .

## Step 2

The paste is intended for cleaning and polishing Quartz sink surfaces. It removes scale, sediment and other stains resulted from using the sink. Regular use will let you keep the sink clean and enjoy having it.

**Use :** Take some paste with a damp cloth and spread it around the entire surface of the sink with circular movements. Then rinse the sink well using water, and wipe dry.

## Step 3

The liquid agent is designed for impregnating the Quartz sink surface. Its unique formula allows it to penetrate into the structure of the Quartz, creating a protective water repellent coating the surface.

It prevents water and dirt absorption and minimises scale formation. It makes cleaning easier and gives a satin gloss finish. It regenerates the surface, masks minor scrapings and tarnished surfaces

**Use :** Spread the liquid with a cloth around the entire surface of the sink with circular movements. Then leave until dry

### Precautions

Irritating to skin. Causes severe eye damage. Keep out of the reach of children,

Prevention : Wash face & hands thoroughly after use.

Wear rubber/latex gloves while using.



If you have difficulties after using this care kit with tougher stains, the recommendation is to use a light water solution of chlorine or sodium hypochlorite. The best practice would be to use this solution and stay with it for about 5 minutes, then carefully rinse the sink with clean water. If the stain persists, repeat this practice one more time.

Once you have finished and the sink is dry, re use the paste and impregnation kit.

An example of a product you can use is **Domestos**.

Contains active: sodium hypochlorite: 4.5 g / 100 g. Ingredients: <5% chlorine bleaching compounds.



1. Regular, preferably daily cleaning of the kitchen sink's surface with dishwashing liquid, hot water and a soft cloth.
2. In the case of calcium deposits, it is recommended to remove the coating with a solution of vinegar or lemon juice.
3. After washing the kitchen sink, rinse it with warm water and wipe it dry. Strongly discolouring liquids or products, such as dyes vegetable juices, tea or coffee essences, should be washed off of the surface of the sink as soon as possible. If left for longer period of time, they may permanently discolour the surface of the product.
4. Avoid cleaning supplies that contain abrasives. You can use a delicate lotion with very fine granules. It is strongly discouraged to clean the sink using rough, sharp tools or steel sponges.
5. In order to protect the sink it is recommended to impregnate the sink once a week using a dedicated product or cooking oil. This procedure should be performed after cleaning and drying the surface of the sink.
6. Using chemical cleaning agents such as dishwasher tablets, drain cleaners, descaling agents, paint removers or toilet cleaners may cause serious and irreversible damage to the sink.
7. Do not drop sharp or heavy objects into the sink as they may chip or damage its surface and/or may be damaged themselves.
8. Hot pots and pans should not be placed directly on the surface of the sink. We recommend putting hot objects on the appropriate rack for hot cookware.
9. Do not use the sink as a cutting surface.
10. Do not use a plastic bowl for dishwashing, this will create regular scuff marks on the surface of the sink over time.

**Recommendations:**

1. The product is intended for use in a household for cleaning food, washing dishes and discharging waste water. It should be used as intended. To ensure proper use, the drain should be kept open.
2. Do not use products that contain strong acids, ammonia, hydroxides, solvents, bleaches or other invasive chemicals to clean the kitchen sink.
3. To avoid direct contact of hot dishes with the surface of the sink use a stand or a mat.
4. Do not leave rubber mats or sponges in the sink. Water trapped underneath can lead to stains and discolouration.
